Designed and built in Australia by Roger Simpson, the Inspiration 11 is a very popular and well respected cruising catamaran. Launched in 2013, Santai has an interior finish superior to many others, combined with great performance under sail and a simple deck layout which makes her a great choice for cruising sailors .

Santai has cruised the East Coast of Queensland and ventured farther offshore to Indonesia and the Louisiades in 2017. The result is an excellently well fit out cruising catamaran that is easily sailed by two people.

Navigation aids include AIS, Radar and autopilot. Her current owners have invested in fitting her out with a new windlass and chain and all new upholstery and covers in 2019. They have also upgraded the refrigeration and added a rain man water maker. She also boasts a portable generator, a 6-person life raft and several other advantageous features for cruising or living aboard.

Santai is fitted with twin Yanmar 30hp diesel motors with just 1700 hours

She comfortably accommodates six in three cabins, with a an optional fourth cabin which has recently been converted to a galley pantry. The forward cabins are extremely spacious for a yacht of her size and the entire yacht offers substantial head room and storage.

There is one large head with electric toilet with macerator and a hot water shower. Power sources come from AGM batteries and very efficient solar panels. The yacht has an auxillary generator and is

Interior

The light-filled roomy interior is bright, and tastefully finished in polished teak veneer with newly upholstered cushions. Fresh air and natural light flow through from the aft cockpit to the saloon, galley and cabins creating a warm, inviting and social feel to the yacht's interior.

SLEEPING ACCOMMODATION

Santai's current layout sleeps 6 comfortably in three cabins. There are two very spacious queen sized cabins in the forward sections of her interior. A third guest (or kids) cabin is located in the starboard aft hull next to the head and shower. The yacht was originally designed with four cabins, and can be converted, however one cabin has recently been converted to a storage 'pantry' next to the galley with additional refrigeration.

THE GALLEY

A great feature of this yacht is its large in-line galley in the port hull. There is ample bench top space to prepare meals on the 3-burner stove or oven with twin stainless sinks with separate hot and cold water taps and a dedicated water filtration system. With twin opening fridge and freezers powered by efficient solar panels and a microwave you'll never be without a cold beverage or a hot meal.

NAVIGATION

All instruments including a Lowrance colour chart plotter with AIS and Radar overlay are situated at the helm station alongside instrument panels for autopilot, wind, speed, depth and compass with VHF radio situated just inside the saloon and accessible from the helm.





On Deck

Santai is easily sailed with two people with an uncluttered deck and cockpit. All lines lead to one set of jammers on the port deck. The current owners hoist the mainsail with a handheld drill and bit called 'the cranker'. Her headsail lines run aft to the cockpit s/t winches with the mainsheet block well aft on a neatly positioned traveller. Non-skid decks and a well positioned foot step allow for easy passage to the fore deck when deploying or weighing anchor - or for lounging on the bow seats with a sun-downer cocktail.



COCKPIT LAYOUT

Santai has a medium sized enclosed cockpit which makes her very safe for young children when underway. Full cockpit covers provide great protection from the elements and insects. Access to and from the water is from two stainless steel boarding ladders. A second shower on the transom offers hot or cold fresh water. There is a davits with inflatable dinghy and outboard and a large storage rack mounted on top which houses a bbq, a life raft and a portable generator - with room for more toys if required.
